On March 30, 2020, the parties filed a Notice of Settlement and Joint Motion to Stay All Deadlines. (ECF No. 60.) The parties represent that they have reached a settlement in principle and are working to finalize the terms of a settlement agreement. (*Id.* at 2.) The parties jointly request that the Court stay all deadlines in the case for 30 days to allow time for the parties to finalize the settlement agreement and to file a joint motion to dismiss. (*Id.*) For good cause shown, the Joint Motion is **GRANTED IN PART**. Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**:

- 1. On or before <u>June 1, 2020</u>, the parties must file simultaneously their Opening Claim Construction Briefs. *See* Patent L.R. 4.4(a).
- 2. On or before <u>June 22, 2020</u>, the parties must file simultaneously their Responsive Claim Construction Briefs. *See* Patent L.R. 4.4(b).
- 3. The Claim Construction and tutorial hearing will be held <u>July 9, 2020</u>, at <u>9:30 AM</u> before Roger T. Benitez. *See* Patent L.R. 4.5.
- 4. All other deadlines set forth in the Case Management Order (ECF No. 43) remain the same.
- 5. A Joint Motion for Dismissal shall be electronically filed on or before <u>April 29, 2020</u>.<sup>1</sup> On the same day the Joint Motion for Dismissal is filed, the proposed order for dismissal, for the signature of the Honorable Roger T. Benitez, shall be e-mailed to the chambers of the Honorable Roger T. Benitez.<sup>2</sup>

Burkhardt. For purposes of the Conference, counsel shall use the Court's conference line: (877) 873-8018; Access code: 9930765.
- 7. If a Joint Motion for Dismissal and proposed order for dismissal are received on or before <u>April 29, 2020</u>, then the Settlement Disposition Conference shall be vacated without further court order.
