ORDER

For the reasons stated during the telephonic hearing held on this date, the Government's Motion to Revoke Defendant's Conditions of Release Pending Sentencing is granted in part and denied in part. Defendant shall be released in this matter from custody pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 3142, 3148, and is released subject to the following conditions:

1. Defendant shall be released to the third-party custody of [REDACTED] and is placed on GPS monitoring in the High Intensity Supervision Program and abide by all conditions of that Program.

2. Defendant shall be placed on 24-hour home detention, meaning he may not leave the residence for any reason except in an emergency.

3. Defendant shall reside with [REDACTED] at [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] Defendant may not travel outside the residence for any purpose without leave of court, except in the event of an emergency.

4. Defendant shall report immediately upon release to 633 Indiana Ave., N.W., 9th floor for installation of the GPS device and, if released after 4 p.m., the following business day.

5. Except as provided herein, Defendant shall not for any purpose use or possess any electronic device, including but not limited to any computer, tablet, or mobile or landline telephone. Defendant may use a communication device for the limited purposes of medical appointments, consultation with counsel, and reporting to Pretrial Services, provided that [REDACTED] is present for any such communication and immediately re-takes possession of the communication device after the communication concludes.

6. Defendant shall not have access to the internet through any means.


7. [REDACTED] (or her counsel) shall notify Pretrial Services via electronic mail of her receipt of any mail matter that she receives at her address that is not addressed to either her or the Defendant, as well as any mail matter that Defendant seeks to send before mailing such matter.

8. Defendant shall call the Pretrial Services Agency twice weekly.

9. Defendant shall refrain from using any drugs or alcohol, except for prescription medication.

10. [REDACTED] (or her counsel) shall notify both the case agent assigned to this matter and Pretrial Services of any violation of these conditions of release by Defendant, immediately upon learning of or suspecting such violation.
