IN RE: WORKGROUP ON THE CONTINUITY OF COURT OPERATIONS AND PROCEEDINGS DURING AND AFTER COVID-19

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Workgroup on the Continuity of Court Operations and Proceedings During and After COVID-19 was established on April 21, 2020,¹ for the purpose of developing findings and recommendations on the continuation of all court operations and proceedings statewide in a manner that protects health and safety and that addresses each of the phases of the pandemic.

The Workgroup was originally scheduled to expire on June 30, 2020, but its term was extended through December 31, 2020.² During the past seven months, the Workgroup has made meaningful and significant contributions to the judicial

branch's response to the pandemic. Given the continuation of the pandemic and in order to allow the Workgroup to complete its pending business, I hereby extend the term of the Workgroup through July 2, 2021. From January 1, 2021, through July 2, 2021, the Workgroup is charged with the following responsibilities:

- Propose rule changes to implement the recommendations submitted by the Workgroup in response to the charges established in Fla.
 Admin. Order No. AOSC20-28. The Workgroup shall file such recommendations in petition form with the Clerk of the Florida Supreme Court. Additionally, the Workgroup is authorized to respond to any comments that may be filed in those rule amendment cases.
- Respond to any others matters that may be referred to the Workgroup by the Chief Justice.

The Workgroup shall continue to utilize the membership established in Fla. Admin. Orders No. AOSC20-28 and AOSC20-35. DONE AND ORDERED at Tallahassee, Florida, on November 23, 2020.
