Any request for a medical or religious exemption to vaccination filed on or after the date of this Notice is untimely and will not be considered. You are not permitted to report to work unless/until such time as you have submitted the required proof of vaccination and that submission has been confirmed by your supervisor. Your absences from work during this period will be charged to your Annual Leave, Compensatory Time and/or PTP accruals as may be applicable.

SHOULD YOU FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THE VACCINATION MANDATE BY THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON APRIL 4, 2022, YOUR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE COURT SYSTEM WILL BE TERMINATED.
