AN ACT CONCERNING THE CREDIT FOR INCOME TAXES PAID TO OTHER STATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That, for the taxable year commencing January 1, 2020, the
- 2 Department of Revenue Services shall not disallow a credit claimed by
- 3 a resident or part-year resident of this state pursuant to the provisions
- 4 of section 12-704 of the general statutes solely because such resident or
- 5 part-year resident was working from home in the state due to the
- 6 COVID-19 pandemic.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the Department of Revenue Services from disallowing a credit claimed by a resident or part-year resident of this state pursuant to the provisions of section 12-704 of the general statutes solely because such resident or part-year resident was working from home in the state due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
