22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-51-806(a)(2), concerning the time for	
23	filing income tax returns, is amended to read as follows:	
24	(2) Returns for all income taxes other than cooperative	
25	associations and exempt organizations shall be filed as follows:	
26	(A) If covering the preceding calendar year:	
27	(i) For a Subchapter C corporation, on or before	
28	April 15; or and	
29	(ii) For all other taxpayers, on or before May 17;

32	of three and one-half (3 ¹ ₂) months after the closing date of the period

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35	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE - SUSPENSION OF CURRENT

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1	(a) This act is cumulative of existing laws and does not repeal but
2	merely suspends any law in conflict with this act, including without
3	<u>limitation § 26-51-806.</u>
4	(b) The provisions of this act are temporary and expire on May 18,
5	<u>2021.</u>
6	(c) On and after May 18, 2021, the provisions of law suspended by this
7	act shall be in full force and effect.
8	(d) The expiration of this act shall not affect rights acquired under
9	this act or affect suits then pending.
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11	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
12	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that it is in the interest of the
13	taxpayer to temporarily change the current deadline for filing and paying
14	state income tax for certain taxpayers as a result of the federal income tax
15	changes to address public health and financial issues related to the
16	coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic; that the federal government has amended
17	the time for filing federal income tax returns to May 17 due to the
18	coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic; that different federal and state income
19	tax filing deadlines will create additional confusion and place a burden on
20	Arkansas taxpayers; and that it is necessary to make immediate changes to the
21	filing deadline to alleviate the financial burden on Arkansas taxpayers
22	before the April 15 deadline. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist,
23	and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
24	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
25	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
26	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
27	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
28	bill; or
29	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
30	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
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
